

IoS events are automatically transmitted using short-range wireless technology (Bluetooth) to a fixed gateway embedded in the BlueDry hair dryer.

Also being announced today, the *BlueDry* blowdryer gateway integrates IoT events from all of your existing IoT devices including Bluetooth toothbrush, hairbrush, toilet seat, bath mirror, and feminine hygiene products[†]. It also gives you shiny, static-free hair and can be used to dry *BlueBar* between baths to avoid unnecessary usage.
